# Information for Parents



## **What is the OOSPA Music Band Program?**

The OOSPA Music Band Program is an opportunity for budding musicians to learn, rehearse and perform in a band environment. They will learn and practice songs with like-minded musicians, guided by a professional in the industry.

## **When and Where will sessions be held?**

Sessions will be held at Berkley in the music room. Students can choose either Wednesday or Thursday. Sessions will be 45 minutes long. Students will receive notice of session times by **Wednesday 16 February**. Lessons will begin the week commencing **Monday 21 February**.

## **What does my child need to take with them?**

It is encouraged that your child has their own guitar, bass guitar, drum sticks or microphone, however it is not essential. Drum kits and keyboard / pianos are provided for use in the music room at Berkley so there is no need to bring those types of instruments.

It is recommended that your child has a clear file for any sheets of music, or lyrics, that the tutor provides so that they can practice at home.

## **Who can enrol in the Band Programme?**

Students who wish to enrol must have consistent playing experience. This can be experience gained from lessons in previous years or an equivalent of 10 – 15 hours (plus) on their instrument. It is recommended that singers do have experience with singing and performing but it is not essential.

## **What is the cost of the Band Programme**

The fee is \$240 for the full year, **payable in full** with the enrolment form. This is effectively \$7.50 per session. **No refunds will be given after the programme has started.** If the OOSPA Band Music Programme is cancelled due to lack of numbers, only then will a full refund will be given.

## **What's else do I need to know?**

Students will have performance opportunities throughout the year where family and whanau members will be invited to attend.

These sessions are **NOT** individual instrument lessons. It is recommended that students should also be enrolled in instrument lessons either at Berkley or through other private instrument lessons.

**We hope that your child enjoys the programme. Please don't get too serious with it all. Music should be fun and not a chore. The aim at this age is to develop what we hope will become a lifelong passion.**
